Important Information

- **Contact-** Our class email is foxes@eastmarkham.notts.sch.uk. This email will be checked during school hours. We will endeavour to answer all emails as swiftly as possible.
- **Water bottles and snacks** – Children should bring a reusable, named water bottle to school every day. A reminder that snacks at break time should be healthy snacks
- **Bags** – Children should bring any items needed in a draw string bag or book bag. Cloakroom space is limited and therefore large bags should no longer be brought into school.
- **P.E** – Y6 PE will take place on a Monday and a Thursday, children will need to come to school in their PE kits on these days.
- **Spellings** – these are tested weekly, on a Friday. We recommend that children continue to use Spelling Shed to practise their spellings.
- **Boom Reader** - Reads at home should be recorded on Boom Reader. If a child reads 4 times or more a week.....
- **Inhalers/medication** – if your child has any medication, such as inhaler, please ensure that we are made aware of this. Children who require an inhaler should bring one that is labelled and can remain at school.
- Our focus value this half term is '**resilience.**' We will have focussed assemblies and class time to consider what respect is, how we can be respectful and what respect may look like in both our school and the wider community.
