Important Information

- Water bottles and snacks Children should bring a reusable, named water bottle to school every day. A reminder that snacks at break time should be healthy snacks.
- Bags Children should bring any items needed in a draw string bag or book bag. Cloakroom space is limited and therefore large bags should no longer be brought into school.
- **P.E** Y4 PE will take place on a **Tuesday**, children will need to come to school in their PE kit. Swimming will take place on **Thursday**, and pupils will long hair must tie it back. Earrings/ piercings are not advised.
- **Spellings** these are tested weekly, on a Friday. We recommend that children continue to use Spelling Shed to practise their spellings.
- Boom Reader Reads at home should be recorded on Boom Reader. If a child reads 4 times or more a week, they will receive an extra 5 minutes of break.
- Inhalers/medication if your child has any medication, such as inhaler, please ensure that we are made aware of this. Children who require an inhaler should bring one that is labelled and can remain at school.
- Our focus value this half term is 'Resilience'. We will have focussed

 resilient and what respect may look like in both our school and the wider
